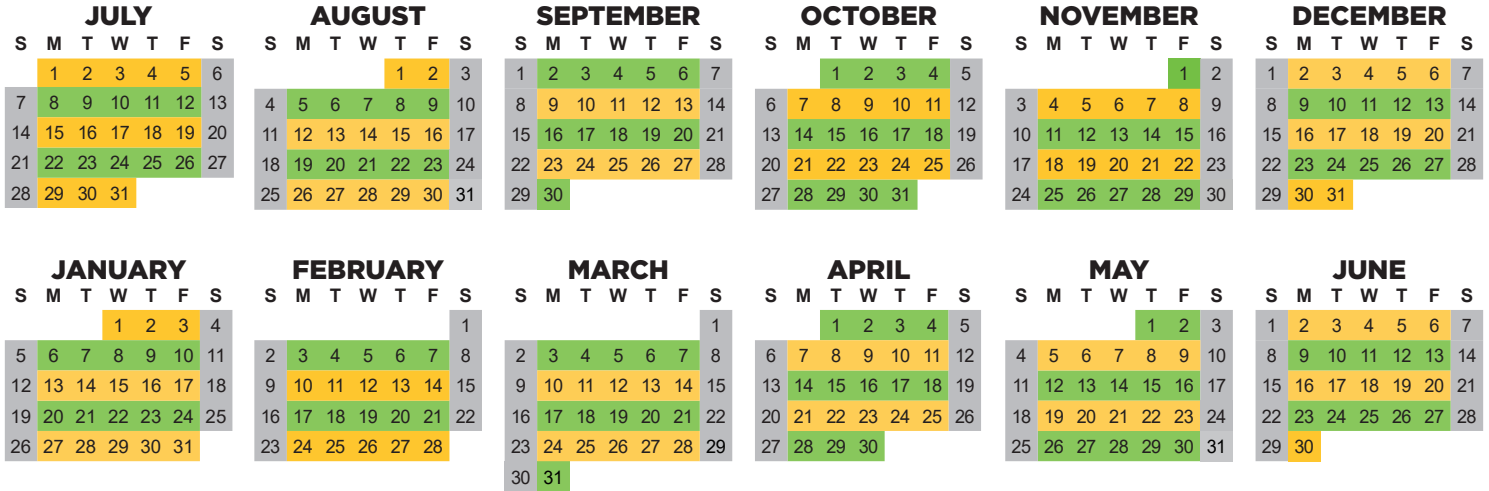

Wet Waste Bin (blue/red lid) is collected **WEEKLY** on your bin day.

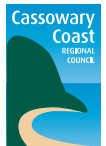
Dry Waste Bin (green lid) is collected **FORTNIGHTLY** on your bin day.

## WEEKLY WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE BY APPROXIMATE AREA

<b>Monday</b>	Boogan, Cardwell, Comoon Loop, East Innisfail Southern, ETTY Bay, Flying Fish Point, Hull Heads, Merryburn, Mission Beach, Moresby, Mourilyan, Silky Oak, South Mission Beach, and Tully Heads. Coconuts, Innisfail town around Hospital, Dove Street, Lily Street, Mourilyan Harbour Road, New Harbour Line Road, East Innisfail middle section, Euramo township.
<b>Tuesday</b>	Belvedere, Cardwell, Cullinane, Damper, Daradgee, Ellerbeck, Garradunga, Goondi, Innisfail town, Kennedy O'Briens Hill, Rockingham, Port Hinchinbrook, Stoters Hill, Tully, and Vasa Views.
<b>Wednesday</b>	Bilyana, Cardwell, Cowley, East Innisfail northern, El Arish, Kurrimine, Murray Upper, Murrigal, Sandy Pocket, Shell Pocket, Silkwood, South Johnstone, Sundown, Tully, Warrabullen, and Wongaling Beach. East Innisfail southern section Marty Street back to highway, Western section along river both sides of Mourilyan Road.

# WASTE AVOIDANCE

Introducing the waste management hierarchy: this framework offers guidance for managing waste, with the most preferred option: **AVOID & REDUCE**.

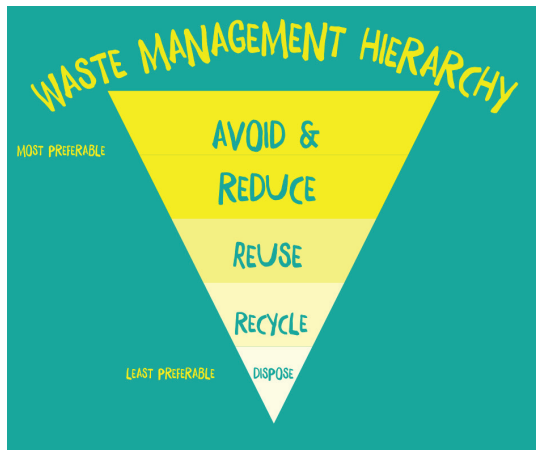
Next time you go shopping, start practising waste avoidance, by being aware of what you are consuming and ask yourself these simple questions:

DO I NEED THIS?

CAN I REUSE THIS?

CAN I RECYCLE/COMPOST THIS?

WHAT IS IT PACKAGED IN AND IS THERE A BETTER OPTION?



# WASTE & RECYCLING

## RECYCLING

Council currently recycle various items at Waste Transfer Stations, Customer Service Centres and Libraries across the region. You can dispose of any of the following domestic items for **FREE**:

- e-waste
- car batteries
- green waste
- ferrous and non-ferrous metal
- approved/rolled fertiliser bags
- cardboard
- glass (container refund scheme only)
- plastic (container refund scheme only)
- Reuse Shop products (at staff discretion)
- solar panels
- paint and engine oil (up to 20 litres)

## DOMESTIC WASTE FEES & CHARGES

Product	Total Fee (inc. GST)
<b>Domestic waste (dry and wet) - Small</b> Up to 0.5m <sup>3</sup>  Example: Car boot, 1/2 6x4 trailer, 2 wheelie bins.	<b>\$10.00</b>
<b>Domestic waste (dry and wet) - Medium</b> > 0.5m <sup>3</sup> to 2.0m <sup>3</sup>  Example: Van, Ute, 6x4 trailer.	<b>\$19.00</b>
<b>Domestic waste (dry and wet) - Large</b> > 2.0m <sup>3</sup> to 4.0m <sup>3</sup>  Example: Ute and trailer, tandem or large trailer, ute or trailer with side extensions.	<b>\$24.00</b>

*Domestic quantities greater than 4.0m<sup>3</sup> will be charged at the Commercial Fee.*

Home composting and worm farming is one small way that we can all **REDUCE** the amount of waste going to landfill - and the reward for both the environment and your garden is huge!

## GREEN WASTE & MULCH

All green waste received at our Waste Transfer Stations is then processed into mulch. Domestic disposal of green waste is **FREE**. Please take care to ensure that green waste is free from contaminants such as star pickets, plastics, wire etc. Mulch is generally available at Transfer Stations for collection. Collection of mulch is **FREE** for domestic residents.

## TIP SHOP/BUY BACK

Council is working to reinstate tip shop facilities.

## SORTING YOUR LOAD

Sorting waste before your vehicle or trailer is loaded makes it safer and easier to unload at the waste transfer stations and presents an opportunity to reduce or avoid charges on disposal.

# COLLECTION SERVICE

Wet waste (blue or red lid bins) are collected **WEEKLY**.  
Dry waste (green lid bins) are collected **FORTNIGHTLY**.

JJ's Waste & Recycling (Council's waste collection contractor) vehicles, have different trucks, for wet and dry waste.



## YOUR BIN, YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

Ensure your bin is out before 6am and returned no later than 24hrs.

Do not overload your bins – it can cause damage to truck equipment and injury to the driver.

Do not put garden waste in the Dry Waste bin.

Do not put large quantities of garden waste in the Wet Waste bin.

Bins should be placed 0.5m from the kerbside, and 1m apart - with the handle and wheels facing your house or property.

Dry & wet waste, eWaste, tyres, gas bottles, fertiliser bags, car bodies, batteries & oil, green waste collection & mulch sales, glass<sup>1</sup>, aluminium<sup>1</sup>, plastics<sup>1</sup>, cardboard, steel, iron & white goods.

### Bells Creek, Mission Beach, Cardwell, Murray Upper and Hull Heads

Dry waste, tyres, gas bottles, drum muster containers\*, batteries & oil, green waste# collection & mulch sales, fertiliser bags (Bells Creek only), glass, aluminium, plastics, cardboard (Mission Beach only), steel, iron & white goods.

# BLUE OR RED LID • WET WASTE BIN

# GREEN LID • DRY WASTE BIN

All items inside kerbside bins will end up in landfill. **WET WASTE** produces leachate that, in combination with high rainfall is a significant environmental risk. It is disposed of at an engineered landfill which is climatically suited and approved by the Department of Environment external to our region. Non-contaminated **DRY WASTE** can be disposed of in landfills in our region.
