An Event to Remember: Council endorses Cassowary Coast Events Strategy 2024-2028

The Cassowary Coast Events Strategy 2024-2028 supports the development of a calendar of sustainable events that draws on the unique attributes of the region as a destination like no other.

Expressions of Interest - Audit Committee Member

Appointment of Independent Chairperson

Cassowary Coast Regional Council is seeking to appoint an independent Audit Committee Chairperson for a four-year term.

In accordance with the Local Government Regulation 2012, Cassowary Coast Regional Council's Audit Committee must be comprised of at least three and no more than six members. Council currently has four members, including the Mayor, a Councillor and two independent members. Council is seeking to recruit an independent Chairperson to lead the Committee in its roles and obligations as per Council's Audit Committee Charter.

Candidates should possess the following qualifications and experience:

- Comprehensive technical knowledge and experience in relation to commerce and financial operations of a large, diverse organisation;
- Understanding of the principles of corporate governance, risk management, performance and efficiency monitoring, the operations of audit committees and of internal and external audit, finance, risk management, commerce and governance;
- The ability to develop strong working relationships with Councillors, Executive Management and Council employees; and
- Excellent communication skills.

Water Main Bulgun Road/Old Tully Road, Feluga

Water Main Work Has Commenced in Feluga

Commencement Date: April 10th, 2024

Duration: Approximately 3 months (Weather permitting)

Location: Bulgun Road/Old Tully Road intersection to Feluga/Midgenoo-Feluga Road intersection.

Traffic Control: This will be in place throughout the duration of the work.

Details: Council initiated the replacement of the water main from the Bulgun Road/Old Tully Road intersection, extending around to the Feluga/Midgenoo-Feluga Road intersection.

The affected area includes the stretch from the intersection of Bulgun Road and Old Tully Road to the Feluga Road intersection, continuing along Feluga Road, and concluding at the Midgenoo-Feluga Road intersection.

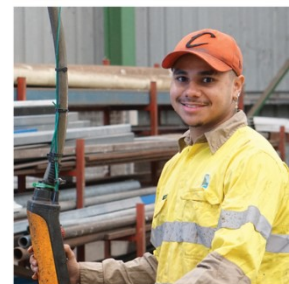
