Approach

Purpose

Cassowary Coast Regional Council commissioned a MARKYT® Community Scorecard to:

- Assess performance against objectives and services in the Community Plan and Corporate Plan
- Benchmark performance
- Determine community priorities
- Seek community suggestions





The Study

Cassowary Coast Regional Council (CCRC) commissioned CATALYSE® to conduct an independent MARKYT® Community Scorecard.

All community members were invited to take part. Scorecard invitations were sent to all households and residential PO Boxes in the Cassowary Coast region using Australia Post's unaddressed mail services. Respondents could complete the scorecard in hard copy or online.

CATALYSE® sent email invitations to CCRC's customer contacts, and CCRC provided supporting promotions through various communication channels. The scorecard was open from 6 May to 7 June 2024.








The scorecard was completed by **2,336 community members** with various connections to the Council:





















Community action plans for community priorities

Local roads

Community driven actions

- 1. Improve the quality of local roads so that they are safe and able to cope with heavy rainfall:
 - grade gravel roads more regularly, especially after storms and heavy rain
 - repair potholes and edges
 - Improve drainage, kerbing, channelling, guttering
 - Paint white lines regularly
- 2. Carry out repairs promptly and to a high standard. Provide permanent solutions, not temporary fixes.
- 3. Advocate for funding to seal gravel roads.
- Advocate for funding to widen high-traffic roads and bridges – particular mention of Tully Mission Beach Rd.

Community Voices

"Dangerous to drive some parts - like Mission to Tully. Council should have a 'duty of care' to provide a safe drive for all."

"Local roads need regular grading, especially in rural areas, with all this rain we have had recently."

> "Slash and grade the non-sealed roads more often. Not once every twelve months that happens now."

"Improvements to all road surfaces in the Shire. Many of us have to bounce through massive potholes whilst driving around our region."

"Widening and installing curb and channeling along the streets on the western side of Cardwell. One street back from the highway and the water pools everywhere and two cars can't pass safely. Rebuilding the road between Cardwell and Tully instead of patching it up."

"Re-mark the white lines on the roads. Roads are difficult to see safely in the rain."

"All the roads need the lines to be remarked regularly to maintain road safety."

"Fix the roads. Bruce Hwy south side is shocking. Bowen St is little more than one lane

and very rough. A number of holes in roads left for an extended periods, with low quality repairs lasting only days."

"Maintenance of local roads. Completely understand weather is an issue.

However, so much money is wasted over time by patchwork,

instead of repairing the issues correctly the first time."

"Seal all gravel roads over a long term programme to 2050 from govt grants."

"Better maintenance of unsealed roads. Have a program to seal unsealed roads."

"East Feluga Road has 3 one lane bridges. This is the main access to Mission Beach during floods. I would like to see these bridges upgraded to dual lane to ensure safety of everyone using this road."

"The Tully / Mission Beach Road urgently needs to be widened and upgraded. I work for a caravan park and travel this road regularly. Considering that the 'grey nomads' bring so much business to our region, I think this should be a priority."



Community safety and crime prevention

Community driven actions

- Advocate for more visible police presence (on foot and vehicle patrols).
- Collaborate with police, community services and government departments to engage with at-risk youth – provide activities, education, training, mentoring and support services.
- Install more CCTV cameras and lighting in well known hot spots (parks, streets and residential areas).
- Provide support services to address homelessness and antisocial behaviour in parks and public places.
- Promote and facilitate a community safety program like Neighbourhood Watch.

Community Voices

"Safety. More police patrolling the main street, on foot, not just driving by."

"Crime. More police to be on the street or driving around the township."

"Working closely with QPS and youth services. Have a community centre and activities which engage youth."

"Work in conjunction with law enforcement and other community service stakeholders to identify ways to educate young offenders and try and engage them in programs and activities to be a more positive member of the community."

"Activities for families and young teenagers. Support for families struggling with behaviour management and engaging activities. More sports and (may need under cover areas due to the wet weather) Futsal, market nights. If kids have things to do they are less likely to be anti-social. Police beat - Visits to schools. Adopt a cop (Drug rehab support, gambling, alcohol)."

"Crime prevention. Better lighting, more CCTV. Programs to engage people in positive activities to stop them re-offending."

"More lighting, security cameras and an official safe night precinct as other Qld towns have. Violence is out of hand in this town."

"Additional CCTV and active monitoring, lighting and security in public areas, work more with police to reduce youth crime and antisocial behaviours from public places."

"Identifying gaps in family and social support networks where people are vulnerable eg children without quality home life and care, homeless families."

"Police presence. Foot patrols, walkthrough of hotels and public spaces. Interaction with owners of the stores, and pedestrians. Govt support to enable this to happen. Nighttime lighting. Sleeping options for the homeless. Showers. Soup kitchen. Youth support."

"Council to be more on board with the community with Neighbourhood Watch, getting the community to work together with prevention and ideas to eradicate crime."



Health and community services

Community driven actions

- Advocate for funding to provide more medical facilities throughout the Shire:
 - GP clinics / medical centres (preferably bulk billing)
 - Specialists
 - Allied health professionals
- Consider ways to attract medical professionals to live and work in the area.
 Suggestions include subsidised housing, paid relocation expenses, subsidised rates and costs of establishing services.
- Advocate for funding to upgrade Tully and Innisfail Hospitals with improved parking, well-trained staff, more beds and better equipment.

Community Voices

"Lobby for doctors and health professionals to be established at places like Mission Beach and Cardwell. Lobby State Government for a new hospital at Tully."

"A fully equipped medical centre with full time team of doctors, nurses, pathologist and reception staff to be able to service the needs of ALL Mission Beach residents and visitors."

"More service for health needs to be provided in Innisfail, so many people need to make the big drive to Cairns to access health services, this causes people loss of daily wages and the cost of fuel to make the journey."

"Some waits at the hospital can be up to 6 hours just to see a doctor. Many people also have to travel to Innisfail or Cairns just to see a specialist.

We need more specialists coming to Tully."

"Access to specialists is very, very difficult. Speech pathology, OT, child health, senior health - hard to get doctor appointments. Have had to go to Emergency at hospital 3 x times this year as no doctor available."

"Continue to work with the public and private health care sector to further develop opportunities for more health care clinics in the region and ways to encourage health care practitioners to relocate to the region."

"Attract and retain GP services. Currently, to see a GP without a prolonged wait is impossible. Perhaps subsidised housing, relocation expenses paid."

"Health and community services. What can council do to attract more services.

Provide buildings? Subsidise rates and costs of establishment?"

"The Tully hospital needs councillors to address health services so an upgrade to hospital can be delivered. This is an area with an aging population. How can we expect good health care workers to want to work here when the hospital is lacking in quality equipment and facilities."

"Upgraded emergency department at Innisfail hospital, upgraded maternity ward, more doctors. More beds available at the hospital, upgraded parking facilities at the hospital."



Economic development and job creation

Community driven actions

- Lobby State and Federal Governments for funding and incentives to draw a wider range of industries to the Cassowary Coast region.
- Attract and support small businesses to stay in the area with economic incentives, lower rates and removal of red tape barriers.
- Be open and supportive of development to create further job opportunities.
- Facilitate more education, training and job opportunities for young people.

Community Voices

"Advocate, lobby for major investors to invest in the region to bring further services to create jobs, to increase tourism and hospitality sector and more population, to reduce rates."

"Work with other levels of government to create sustainable industries. Work other than bananas to give more opportunities to locals and backpackers."

"CCRC needs to bring more industry to the Cassowary Coast so more jobs could be created. Also, this would diversify the economy of the Cassowary Coast."

"There need to be incentives and support for new small and micro businesses, not only in terms of financial support but also education for small business owners and prospective entrepreneurs. There needs to be education around financial management, employment, and ways of finding grants and instruction on how to write submissions for funding."

"Encourage, help and promote businesses to start up/move to the area, a strong business district generates financial and population growth ensuring a stronger council through a larger rates payer base. Increasing rates on a smaller population base does the opposite of the above."

"Council's rates impede start up for small businesses. We have looked at starting a business though rentals are high and to purchase outright and then meet rates charges with all other costs, makes this opportunity non viable."

"Welcome business and development into the shire. In the past we have lost so much development - so much red tape and rules - businesses have gone to other shires."

"Council has a long reputation for being anti-development, and making life hard for business owners . . . If they turned their attention to making it easier for businesses there would be more businesses to share the rates load, and less vacant shops in the main streets. Which in turn creates jobs and generally helps the economy."

"Encourage and support local businesses to employ apprentices and trainees as there are so many young people out of work."

"There is a need to attract / keep young people in the area. The CCRC needs to make concessions for parties interested in setting up a business - a need to seek out possible ventures."



Footpaths, trails and cycleways

Community driven actions

- Ensure all footpaths are safe and accessible for all users including people in wheelchairs, children on scooters, prams etc.
- Maintain and repair footpaths to a higher standard - repair uneven surfaces, curb and channel for drainage, keep clear of plants and debris, clean and remove mould etc.
- Advocate for a more extensive, connected network of footpaths and cycleways to encourage walking and cycling for health, transport and recreation.
- Provide more lighting on footpaths and cycleways.

Community Voices

"Footpaths. Maintain and make sure they are level as there have been a few falls over the years due to this."

"Great need for improved drainage in Mission Beach. Some of the footpaths have no channelling and kerbing. Also, they are full of black slime and algae for a big part of the year. Also, to help with local flooding problems."

"Walking paths - Kurrimine Beach - unsafe re debris on paths - coconuts."

"The path along the whole foreshore at Cardwell is a wonderful asset but poorly managed. Every year the mould is so thick that it's a real slip hazard and it's only cleaned off in patches. It also needs to be sealed afterwards to prevent the mould coming back."

"Upgrade the paths so that they are wider and safer for pedestrians and bikes/ e-scooters and mobility scooters and parents with prams."

"Plan to improve the local paths as a priority. At South Mission Beach there is only a gravel path along the beach front - that is not wheelchair, pram or suitable for the elderly to use. It is poorly lit and there are no bins."

"Dirt walkways or pathways need to be upgraded to promote South Mission Beach but also give access to people in wheelchairs or who have a disability."

> "Footpaths, trails, cycleways outside of main town area, ie. if anyone in South Johnstone or Wangan wanted to cycle or walk / run to town they can't without the risk of being killed by traffic."

"Footpaths to connect the entire villages, from South Mission to Bingil Bay, for health, exercise, mental health, tourism, elderly, people with walking aides - to encourage people to feel safe on the pathways."

"Riding a bike here is dangerous. I have suffered permanent injury on an Innisfail footpath. Enact a strategy to make cycling possible and lobby TMR to put through the Bruce Hwy Bypass to avoid the centre of Innisfail."

"Lighting is poor along streets / footpaths and Esplanade. Early morning is unsafe for pedestrians to go walking."



Seniors' care and services

Community driven actions

- Advocate for a range of housing and care options for seniors, ranging from lifestyle villages to higher care facilities.
- Advocate for improved access to assisted living, health care, home care and services to enable older residents to remain at home.
- · Provide a community bus service for seniors.
- Provide spaces for seniors to gather and activities to keep seniors healthy and connected.
- Improve accessibility for people with disability and mobility issues (ramps, rails, seating, parking spaces, public toilets etc).
- Improve communication about services available to seniors – have a central point of contact.

Community Voices

"Look into retirement villages or extra nursing homes, due to the aging population."

"As an aging population we desperately need more care facilities and an assisted living village for those who don't need 24 hour care"

"More home assistance for the elderly."

"An aging population needs facilities/services to help keep people in their homes longer. More Community Care Packages, more help services like transportation.

More local things so travel isn't required out of region."

"Senior care is very limited and costly. Most jobs around your home are met with a negative response. We would all love to stay independent but not easy with limited help. Also, neighbours think of you as invisible when you are senior."

"As our community ages maybe a minibus to take them shopping, appointments or to activities organised here at Mission Beach."

"We need better help for the elderly in the community and others to have more transport to appointments in Cairns (bring back the Rail Motor)."

"Provide more places for older people to meet."

"A major factor to maintain health in older locals is keeping fit. Tully has virtually no game type activities seniors can play when it rains, which lately is most of the time. Since we do not have one covered tennis court, tennis has been all but eliminated.

We NEED the Igloo for Pickleball."

"Have a streamlined process for senior services where the different services communicate. It is a nightmare trying to organise help for my parents."

"There needs to be a central point of contact and more communication around what services are offered. In my experience, If you don't know what to ask for then I have found none of the services are forthcoming with information."

"More help for the elderly, better parking and more ramps to assist with accessibility."

"We need more disability parking spaces. We need better access to footpaths for mobility scooters and walkers. Accessible disability toilets, eg. Etty Bay."



Waste collection services

Community driven actions

- Provide households with recycling bins and kerbside recycling collection services. Ensure recycling waste is recycled.
- Provide more rubbish bins in public places (including recycling bins) and empty public bins more often.
- Provide free tip passes for residents and improve accessibility to the tips (keypad entry, longer opening hours).
- Provide a bulk waste rubbish collection service once or twice a year.
- · Provide larger bins for general/wet waste.

Community Voices

"Waste. Proper recycling would be wonderful. We were advised by council that all waste is going into landfill."

"Looking forward to having recycling. Hoping this will also mean an upgrade to the bins in town to include recycling too. Encouraging local businesses to recycle and also provide bins for container for change collection."

"Waste. Recycle bins that do get proper recycling. When this is introduced, fine people who do not comply. Put the bins back around the place please.

Absolute necessary, and ridiculous when removed."

"The waste management 'system' is a joke. No actual recycling happens, despite us being asked to separate rubbish. We need to get serious about recycling. Bins in the town area and beyond should require the rubbish to be separated."

"Bring back the bins to public areas that were removed last year. It is totally inappropriate to remove the bins in public places frequented by lots of tourists."

"More rubbish bins around in public places. Such a disgrace to have tourists come through & see overflowing bins everywhere. A lasting memory & word of mouth will do the district much damage. It needs to be addressed for locals' pride in their district too.

Bins need to be emptied more often."

"Bring back being able to use the tip for free, for what we all pay in rates it's the least you could do."

"Dump needs to be open at 8am for summer - 10am too hot and too late to join the queue. Bring back key code pad - was heaps easier."

> "Have a road side clean up once or twice a year. This helps families who can not access the dump."

"Kerb pickup yearly. And green waste for those who cannot take it to the dump."

"The wet waste bins need to be larger."

"Providing large size wheelie bins for general waste collection. Free dump days.

Regular green and hard waste kerbside collection."



Council's leadership

Community driven actions

- Improve community engagement involve the community in decision-making, re-open Council meetings to the public, listen to and act on residents' concerns.
- Act with honesty, transparency and integrity at all times.
- Review the structure of the organisation so it's less top heavy.
- · Provide better value for money from rates.

Community Voices

"Listen to the community and give them a chance to put forward ideas, rather than it all being decided by a select few."

"Need to open council meetings back up to the public. Covid is over, no need for the online viewing. More public input to council meetings back to basics."

"CCRC Executive Team need more interaction with community. Consultation.

More open public meetings with rate payers. We need to see our councillors out in the community more."

"Transparency and communication with the community - foster a culture of transparency where leaders are open about organisational goals, challenges, and changes. Regular communications can keep the public and employees informed and engaged. Open lines of communication encourage trust and collaboration."

"When approached, councillors need to listen and take on board what is said. Do not go on the defensive. They deserve respect but so does the community."

"Leadership needs to be honest and transparent. There is NO room for own agendas.

Must remember ratepayers provide your pay. Do them proud."

"Council leadership. Need to consult people who could be affected, but councillors must be open and honest with the community. Do not lie, do not cover up, be upfront and open."

"Too top heavy. Stop employing directors and start putting more people on the ground.

And the people on the ground need to be paid properly for their work."








