Frequently Asked Questions

Council is going paperless for a greener and cleaner future and are starting with rate notices.

What does this mean for property owners?

Commencing 1 July 2025, rate notices that are mailed will be charged a printing and postage fee of \$2.25 per rate notice (residents in receipt of the pension concession will be exempt).

How do I not get charged this fee?

If you are in receipt of a pension concession and the concession is listed on your rate file, no fee will be charged.

Alternatively, you can have your rate notice emailed free of charge.

Sign up by visiting *cassowarycoast.ezybill.com.au* or scan the QR code below and follow the steps to register for eRates.



I'm a pensioner and I own two properties. Will I be exempt on both properties?

No. You will only be exempt on the property that you currently receive your pension concession on.

I have a Seniors Card. Will I be exempt?

No. Unless you are in receipt of a pension concession and the concession is listed on your rate file, you will not be exempt.

Are not-for-profit organisations exempt from the printing and postage fee? No.

I receive more than one rate notice in my envelope. Does this mean I will only be charged one fee of \$2.25?

No. You will be charged \$2.25 per rate notice regardless of how many notices are in one envelope.

What other benefits do I receive by signing up to eRates?

- Receive your rate notice straight away;
- All rate notices are stored in the online portal and can be downloaded onto your selected device;
- Save paper and reduce your carbon footprint.



What if I sign up to eRates and then later decide it's not for me?

You can deregister your eRates account at any time and your rate notices will then be mailed once again.
